FOOTBALL TIPS & TRICKS



Cross-Legger: AKA: (Maradona Kick) when the ball is on the right side of you, you bend your right knee and bring your left leg BEHIND your right knee and kick the ball. (Good for awkward situations, and off-leg kicks)

Cryuff Turn: take your right foot, and act as you are going to shoot the ball (or pass) and then at the last moment just push it behind your left foot, and run that way.
