SEMI FINAL & FINAL RULES

Only two borrowed players are allowed.

Knockout Semifinals - The four teams play a single knockout round and the winner of each game will proceed to the Final. The round will be 1V4 and 2V3.

In a semifinal game, in the case of goals being equal at the end of normal time two ten minute periods of extra time are played. There is a five minute break between the end of the game and the start of the first period of extra time. There is no break between the two periods of extra time.

The winner is determined as follows during that extra time :

Finals:

In finals games, the winner is determined as follows:

The team with the highest number of goals at the end of normal time wins.

In the case of goals being equal at the end of normal time two ten minute periods of extra time are played. There is a five minute break between the end of the game and the start of the first period of extra time. There is no break between the two periods of extra time.
