President's Report

Not a lot to say this week about football - you can read the results below so I won't repeat them - so I thought I might take the opportunity to talk a bit about Narrabeen Football Club - the club itself. Narrabeen Football Club was established in 1965 as a section of Narrabeen Youth Club. Nearly forty-five years later it has grown to more than 50 teams and 665 players. The club caters for a range of players from under 6 to over 35 and takes part in competitions organised by Manly Warringah Football Association, playing on grounds across the Northern Beaches against teams from Mosman to Avalon. There are mixed junior (U10-U18) and sub-junior (U6-U9) teams playing on Saturday mornings, senior men (U21+) playing on Saturday afternoon and womens teams (junior and senior) playing on Sundays. Due to a shortage of grounds on Saturdays, and in the event of wet weather requiring catch-up games to be played, some junior and senior teams have games on Sundays too.

For many of you I'm not telling you something you don't already know and you're probably wondering why I'm writing about it. It's really just to illustrate the point that the club exists to provide playing opportunities for a wide range of players, and a considerable number of them too. This takes time and resources. It's thanks to a relatively small group of volunteers that all this happens - the people who produce this newsletter each week, ensure our grounds are fit for play, deal with the enormous number of registrations at the start

of the season and a stream of queries as players change teams, bank the cheques and tally up the cash payments, make sure that everyone knows where they are playing each week, grade the players at the start of the season, make sure the teams are kitted out in Narrabeen gear and organise helpers to staff the canteen each week. I'm sure I've missed out many more tasks that keep the club ticking but the point is that we depend on volunteers to step up and take on these roles so that the club can continue to flourish. It doesn't necessarily take up a lot of time to get involved - maybe one or two evenings a month and a few hours here and there. We're coming towards the end of this season and all that involves, but already starting to think about next season and what needs to be done to be ready for it. Please keep an eye out for notice of the AGM and if you think you could contribute, please put your hand up!
